Research & Development European Innovation Council



Support groundbreaking deep tech projects that possess high scientific and technological ambition and risk (TRL 1-4) and have the potential to create new markets. Research teams, consortia or individual applicants are eligible to apply.

Grants of up to EUR 3 million or EUR 4 million along with coaching, mentoring, and networking opportunities



Transition

Validate technologies and create business plans for specific applications at TRL 3 to 6. SMEs, spin-offs, start-ups, research organizations, and universities (either individual applicants or small consortia) are eligible to apply. Grants of up to EUR 2.5 million are available, along with booster grants for ongoing projects and tailored Business Acceleration Services.





Develop and scale up innovations with market-creating or disruptive potential (TRL 6-8), following the patient capital principle. Start-ups, SMEs, individuals planning to launch an SME, and small mid-caps (equity-only) are eligible to apply. Grants up to EUR 2.5 million and equity investments up to EUR 10 million are available, along with coaching, mentoring, and networking.

Additional funding opportunities



CBE JU Partnership

A joint initiative of the European Commission and the Bio-based Industries Consortium (BIC), the CBE JU (Circular Bio-based Industries Joint Undertaking) funds projects that promote circular bio-based industries in Europe. It is co-financed by contributions from the EU and the industry, operating under the same rules as Horizon Europe projects. Among the calls for the 2025 program, there will be a specific call titled "Scaling-up Nutritional Proteins from Alternative Sources," which will open in April.



European Circular Bioeconomy Fund (ECBF)

First private venture capital impact fund exclusively dedicated to bioeconomy. ECBF invests in technologies, products, processes, business models, and emerging value chains linked to bio-based products derived from renewable resources. The targeted industry sectors include agriculture and food, forestry, blue economy, industrial biotech, bio-based chemicals and materials, packaging, personal and home care, construction, textiles, and others. Investment focus: Companies or projects with Technology Readiness Level (TRL) 6-9 and initial commercial traction. Investment size: Between €2.5 million and €10 million. A commitment to Environmental, Social, and Governance (ESG) principles is required. Contributions to CO₂ reduction, biodiversity, circularity, and mitigation of toxic substances are highly valued.


